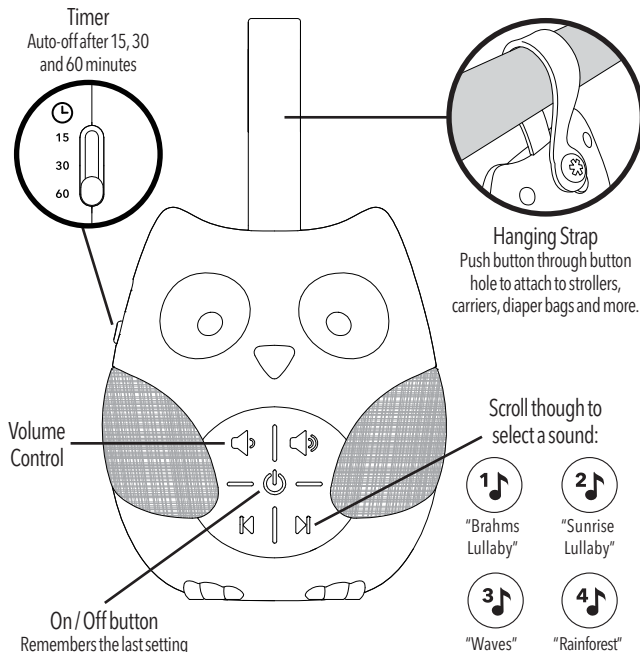


STROLL & GO portable baby soother

CLEANING AND CARE:

Clean with dry cloth only.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:



IMPORTANT! Keep for future reference.

Read all instructions and warnings carefully before use of the portable baby soother.

⚠️ WARNING: ALWAYS use with adult supervision. DO NOT leave baby unattended with product. NEVER place product in crib. Product is not intended for use in cribs. NEVER use this product in a motor vehicle. Do not allow this item or any other product to interfere with proper functioning of carrier or stroller restraint system. Only use with baby seated with harness straps in place. Remove and discard all packaging material prior to use.

Battery Information:
Install/replace batteries (by adult only): Requires 3 AAA batteries.

1. Open battery cover with screwdriver
 2. Insert or replace with 3 AAA 1.5V batteries. Be sure to insert with the correct polarity.
 3. Replace cover and secure screws with screwdriver.
- At the end of the product life, remove batteries from product by following the above battery replacement instructions. Always dispose of used batteries properly. See section on safety and disposal information. To prolong the life of this product remove batteries when toy is in storage.

- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Do not burn batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.

CONSUMER INFORMATION: SAFETY AND DISPOSAL

At end of product life remove batteries from product by following the battery replacement instructions. Substances used in batteries pose potential environmental and health effects. Do not mix waste batteries with other waste. Keep waste batteries separate. Do not dispose of by landfill or by incineration. Return waste batteries to your point of purchase or recycle
